Arguably the biggest match of the season to date went down this past weekend in the FVSL Premier Division. There was also a key result at the bottom of the table and a mid-table clash with impacts on the top four. This was also the final week through the schedule before the first round of reverse fixtures start and it was the inaugural week for the *TWU Spartans Challenge Fixture*. Our Match of the Week this past weekend was the first place showdown in **Division 1** between **Tzeachten FC** and **TWU Spartans B**. The match lived up to the hype as well with plenty of the big name usual suspects playing a role. In the end, a goal by TWU's **Lothario Milfrise** was not enough to overcome tallies by **Dale Long** and **Matthew Aikema** for Tzeachten and the division leaders secured a 2-1 win to maintain their perfect record, opening up an eight-point gap at the top of the table. A 4-1 success for **TSS FC Rovers II U21** over **Surrey United SC B** saw them pull level in the standings with TWU. **Andrew Matsugu** was the hero for TSS, scoring a brace in the win. Just behind TSS and TWU are **North Delta SC NEWWAY** who got a pair of goals from **Dallyn Simpson** for the second straight week which was good enough for a 2-1 victory against **Premier Academy U21**. There was an entertaining 3-2 win for **FC Tigers Vancouver B** as they held off a late push by **Surrey United SC Reds U21** to claim three points. Elsewhere there were straightforward 4-1 and 5-1 wins for **Langley United B** and **Port Moody Piranhas** over **Abbotsford United C** and **Juba FC** respectively.

There was more frustration for **Ridge Meadows SC United** in **Division 2A** this week, as, despite a slip up from leaders **Abbotsford United B**, Ridge Meadows were unable to reduce the deficit at the top and it remains a six point gap. A goal by **Harvey Dehil** for **Aldergrove United Highlanders** cancelled out a striker by Abby's **Ishwar Gill** as the sides split the points in a 1-1 draw. It was a rare blemish for the still undefeated Abbotsford, but Ridge Meadows failed to capitalize, as they were held to a tie as well, finishing 2-2 against **Langley United U21**. However, **Mission SC A** were able to take advantage and pull level in second with Ridge Meadows after beating **Surrey United SC Elite** 4-1 thanks in part to a pair of goals from **David Vanderhoek**. There were no slips at the top of **Division 2B**, particularly for leaders **North Surrey Mustangs A** who rode an impressive four-goal performance by **Kamaleddin Ezz** to a 7-2 pasting of **Langley United Young Guns**. Mustangs remain five points up on both **Coastal FC**, who beat **FC Tigers Vancouver** 2-0, and **Langley United Dynamo**, who were 1-0 winners over **Surrey United SC C** courtesy of a **Cameron Whitters** goal.

In possibly the most eye-catching result of the weekend **Division 3A** co-leaders **Langley United Impact** saw it all go wrong in a 6-0 loss to **Abbotsford SA Graduates U21**. There was no stopping **Ishminder Dhaliwal** on this night as he scored four goals in to stun the Impact and lift Graduates into third place. It

was all music to the ears of **Poco FC Rockets**, who took full advantage of the situation to pull three points clear at the top after a 2-0 win over **Ridge Meadows SC Rowdies**. Over in **Division 3B** a 1-1 draw with **North Delta SC Titans** saw **WRU Cloverdale FC A** drop two points at the top of the table. **Zachary Pilch** scored for Cloverdale, while **Chris Ellett** was on target for Titans. Cloverdale remain in third place lose ground on second place **Pacific United FC**, who edged **BCT Westside United** 3-2, and first place **Ladner FC**, who were comprehensive 5-1 winners over **North Delta SC Royals**.

There were two big results in **Division 4** this weekend. The first came from 4A where **Poco FC Athletic** got goals from **Diego Mazzarolo** and **Sam Cornelson** to post a 2-0 win over **Mission SC B** who had come into the weekend atop the table. Elsewhere, **Stuart Chernoff** scored a hatrick to lead **Tri City FC B** to a 5-1 win over **Ridge Meadows SC Folly**. Across in 4B **Aldergrove United Lowlanders** were able to keep the division's leading scorer, **Jason Brand** from **North Delta SC United SJ**, quiet, but still succumbed to a 4-3 defeat that allowed SJ to overtake them for first place. **Harman Deol** and **Kyle Howe** did the heavy lifting in place of Brand as they each scored twice in the win.

There were no changes at the top in **Masters 1** this weekend. First place **Langley United Knights** got braces from both **Christian Bessman** and **Jason Flint** in a 5-0 win over **Aldergrove United Players**, with **Craig Montague** posting the Knights first clean sheet of the season in the win. Second place **North Delta SC Rangers** did their best to keep pace, beating **WRU South Surrey FC** 2-0 thanks to goals from **Jairo Rodriguez** and **Richard Warnock**, as well as a third shutout of the season for **Graham Baskott**. Meanwhile, **Surrey United SC** are up to third place after their 2-1 win over **Chilliwack Rapids**, with **Keegan Munn** and **Trevor Tagieff** scoring for Surrey to outdo Chilliwack's lone tally from **Mike Perry**. In **Masters 2**, the perfect record remains for **Ridge Meadows SC Wolves** after a 2-0 win over **Langley United** and Wolves are now ten points clear in first place after second place **America United FC** were forced to settle for a 2-2 draw with **Whalley City**. Over in **Masters 3** first place was reclaimed by **Langley United Heat** who beat **North Delta SC Phoenix** 4-0 due largely to a hatrick for **Bojan Lazic**. Things are quite tight at the top, though, and the entire division holds a game in hand over Langley!

## MATCH OF THE WEEK

We head back to Division 3 this week where we find first place Ladner FC hosting second place Pacific United FC. Since we last checked in on Ladner, they have emerged from a tight scrap at the top of the table to lead the division by two points. After a slow start, Ladner have won eight straight games. Levi Shevernoha still powers the machine offensively for Ladner, but Cameron Dhaliwal has emerged as a key leader and popped up with some timely goals of his own. Beyond them, Adam Bosch continues to add to the offense, while Daniel Porter has chipped in with some saves in key moments.

The only team to beat Ladner this season was, in fact, Pacific United FC. Back in the second week of the season, Pacific cruised to a 4-1 win in the reverse fixture at Newton Athletic Park. On that night Karamveer Bhullar, Pargat Singh Sandhu and Banpreet Singh all got in on the scoring act, while Ladner also added to their own demise by scoring an own goal. Pacific managed to achieve that result without the offense of two of their biggest threats in Tajinder Singh Grewal and Inderpal Singh Gill. As potent as the Pacific attack is, their defense has also contributed to their success. Goalkeeper Navdeep Gill sits atop the Division 3 Golder Glove standings with three clean sheets to his name this season. Pacific will
